



SUBJECT: FREEZEMASTERTM ANTIFREEZE CANADIAN COMPLIANCE

Dear Customer,

The purpose of this message is to provide you with information regarding the Canadian compliance status of FreezemasterTM Antifreeze. This letter is in junction to the compliance language located in Section 15 of the Canadian and US SDS.

FreezemasterTM Antifreeze is comprised of components listed on Canada's Chemical Inventory, known as the Domestic Substance List (DSL). However, one polymer in the FreezemasterTM Antifreeze formulation is not listed on Canadian DSL. According to Canada's Guidelines for the Notification and Testing of New Substances: Chemicals and Polymers:

- 1. A polymer that is not listed on the Canadian DSL may be imported at quantities <1 MT/year
- 2. A polymer that is not listed on the Canadian DSL must be registered should import quantities exceed >1 MT/year

Given the regulation and the prevalence of the unlisted polymer in our product, you may import the following quantities of FreezemasterTM Antifreeze into Canada:

• < 10,370,000gallons/year or < 44,444 MT/year
